Preparing to Use the Dreamweaver Interface

Scenario:

You may want to provide information about your company through a website. You decide to create it using the Adobe Dreamweaver application. Before proceeding, you may want to be thorough with the location and functionality of the applications interface elements. Also, you may want to modify the interface, so that the required tools can be accessed easily.

1. Open the Adobe Dreamweaver application.
2. From the My Documents\Your Folder\Dreamweaver Files\Getting Started with Dreamweaver\Citizens Info folder, open the index.html file.
3. In the **INSERT** panel, from the drop-down list, select the various categories to view their options.
4. Hide the **AP ELEMENTS** panel.
5. Dock the **CSS STYLES** panel to the left of the document window.
6. Group the **ASSETS** panel with the **CSS STYLES** panel.
7. Save the workspace layout as *Customized_yourfirstname*.
