

Before You Begin:

Open both Internet Explorer and index.html.

Scenario:

You have come up with an interesting motto for your community and you would like to display it at the center of the web page. You also intend to display the motto in a unique font set apart from the rest of the content.

What You do	How you do it
1. Indent the motto of your community	<p>(a) In the Notepad window, click after <i>Newsroom Contact Us</i> </p> and press Enter</p> <p>(b) Type <blockquote>Dedicated to Bringing People Together to Discuss Issues

2. Preserve the spacing and line break of the motto.

- (a) Switch to the Notepad++ window and click after the `<blockquote>` tag and type `<pre>`
- (b) Click before the `</blockquote>` type `</pre>`
- (c) Click after the "issues" press **Shift** and then click after the `</br>` tag
- (d) Press **Delete** to delete the `
` tag and press **Enter**
- (f) Save the file and switch to Internet Explorer
- (g) Click the **Refresh (F5)** button to display a line break
