## Formatting Text Using Inline Styles

### Data Files:

Download **Index3-1.html** to your folder

Download **communities.gif** to your graphics folder

Download **logo.jpg** to your graphics folder

Download **bullet.jpg** to your graphics folder

### Before You Begin:

Open the **index3-1.html** file in the Notepad

Open the **index3-1.html** file in a browser

### Scenario:

While the home page is coming together nicely, there are numerous formatting issues that need to be addressed. The text for the page footer is aligned to the left of the page and this makes the footer appear as part of the main content. You would like to separate it from the main content by aligning it to the center of the page.

What you do	How you do it
1. Format the footer of the page using an inline style sheet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) In the <b>Browser</b> window, scroll down to display the page footer section.</li><li>(b) <i>Observe</i> that the page footer text is aligned to the left of the page.</li><li>(c) Switch to the Notepad application.</li><li>(d) Scroll down and in the <code>&lt;p&gt;</code> tag containing the page footer text, click after <code>&lt;p&gt;</code> to place the insertion point.</li><li>(e) Press the <b>Spacebar</b> and type <code>style="text-align: center"</code> to apply text styles to the text inside the <code>&lt;p&gt;</code> tag. <i>See Code Sample 1.</i></li><li>(f) Save the file</li></ul>

2. Verify the changes in the browser	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) On the taskbar, click <b>Citizens Information Center - Windows Browser</b> to display the <b>Browser</b> window.</li><li>(b) In the <b>Citizens Information Center Windows Browser</b> window, click the <b>Refresh</b> button to <i>verify</i> that the page footer is aligned to the center of the web page.</li></ul>
