

# ACTIVITY 3-2

## Formatting Headings Using Embedded Style Sheets

### Data Files:

Index3-1.html

### Before You Begin:

Open the **index3-1.html** file in the Notepad

Open the **index3-1.html** file in a browser

### Scenario:

You will find the headings in the home page that really don't stand out very well. You would like to fix this issue by giving a distinct look and color to the headings.

What you do	How you do it
1. Insert an embedded style sheet container.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) Scroll up and in the documents &lt;head&gt; section, click after the &lt;/ title&gt; tag and press <b>Enter</b>.</li><li>(b) Type <b>&lt;style type="text/css"&gt;</b></li><li>(c) Press <b>Enter</b> and type <b>&lt;/style&gt;</b></li></ul>
2. Set the font family and the font size of the heading text.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) Click after the &lt;style type="text/css"&gt; tag and press <b>Enter</b>.</li><li>(b) Type <b>h3 {</b> <b>font-family:</b> <b>Arial,Verdana,sans-serif;</b> <b>}</b> to specify the font family of the heading text.  <i>See Code Sample 1.</i></li><li>(c) Save the file, switch to the <b>Browser</b> window, and refresh the page.</li><li>(d) Observe that the font family of the heading text is changed to <b>Arial</b>.</li><li>(e) Switch to the Notepad application.</li><li>(f) In the style rule for the <b>h3</b> tag, click after font-family: Arial,Verdana, sans-serif; and press <b>Enter</b>.</li><li>(g) Type <b>font-size: 13px;</b> to set the font size of the heading text.</li><li>(h) Save the file, switch to the <b>browser</b> window, and refresh the page.</li><li>(i) Observe that the font size of the heading text has changed.</li></ul>

<p>3. Specify the margins of the heading text</p>	<p>(a) Switch to the Notepad application.</p> <p>(b) Press <b>Enter</b> and type  <code>margin-left: 15px;</code>  to set the margins of the heading text.</p> <p>(c) Save the file, switch to the <b>browser</b> window, and refresh the page.</p> <p>(d) Observe that the margins for the left side of the heading text have been set.</p>
<p>4. Apply a color to the heading text.</p>	<p>(a) Switch to the Notepad application.</p> <p>(b) Press <b>Enter</b> and type <code>color: #001A5C;</code>  to apply a blue color to the heading text.</p> <p>(c) Save the file, switch to the <b>Browser</b> window, and refresh the page.</p> <p>(d) Observe that the color of the heading text has changed to blue.</p>
<p>5. Set the margins for the &lt;body&gt; element.</p>	<p>(a) Switch to the Notepad application.</p> <p>(b) Click after the closing braces of the h3 style rule and press <b>Enter</b>.</p> <p>(c) Type  <code>body {</code>  <code>margin: 0;</code>  <code>}</code>  to set the margins of the &lt;body&gt; element to zero.</p> <p>(e) Save the file, switch to the <b>Browser</b> window, and refresh the page to verify that the margin is set to zero for the body elements.</p>
