Formatting Images

Data Files:

Download **Index3-1.html** to your folder

Before You Begin:

Open the index3-1.html file in the browser and in the Notepad application.

Scenario:

The text formatting of the home page is complete and looks neat and consistent. But you find that the main text appears below the image and this makes the web page look like a text document in which text and graphics are arranged sequentially. You want to fix this by making the graphics appear to the right of the text.

What you do	How you do it
1. Modify the width of the image	<p>(a) Open index3-1.html in Notepad window, in the <code><head></code> section, in the embedded style sheet, click after the closing braces of the <code>p. bodypara</code> class style rule and press Enter.</p> <p>(b) Type <code>. image</code> to declare an independent class selector and press the Spacebar.</p> <p>(c) Type <pre>{ width: 460px; }</pre>to specify the width of the image.</p> <p>(d) Scroll down and in the <code><body></code> section, in the second <code></code> tag containing the <code>communities.gif</code> image, click after <code><img,</code> press the Spacebar, and type class="image" <i>See Code Sample 1.</i></p> <p>(e) Save the file, switch to the Browser window, and refresh the page.</p> <p>(f) Observe that the width of the <code>communities</code> image is set according to your style declarations.</p>

2. Wrap text to the left of the <code>communities.gif</code> image	<p>(a) Switch to Notepad</p> <p>(b) Scroll up and in the image class style rule, click after <code>width: 460px :</code> and press Enter</p> <p>(c) Type float: right; to move the image to the right of the page and wrap text to the left of the image.</p> <p>(d) Save the file, switch to the Browser window, and refresh the page.</p> <p>(e) Observe that the <code>communities.gif</code> graphic is moved to the right of the page and the text gets wrapped to the left of the image.</p>

<p>3. Wrap text to the right of the news.jpg image</p>	<p>(a) Switch to the Notepad application.</p> <p>(b) In the <head> section, in the embedded style sheet, click after the closing braces of the <i>image class</i> style rule and press enter</p> <p>(c) Type</p> <pre>.newsimage { float: left; }</pre> <p>to wrap text to the right of the image.</p> <p>(d) Scroll down and in the <body> section, in the third image tag containing the news.jpg image, click after , press the Spacebar and type</p> <pre>class="news image"</pre> <p><i>See Code Sample 2.</i></p> <p>(e) Save the file, switch to the Browser window, and refresh the page.</p> <p>(f) Observe that the text gets wrapped to the right of the news.jpg image.</p>

<p>4. Apply margins to the news.jpg image</p>	<p>(a) Switch to the Notepad++ application.</p> <p>(b) Scroll up and in the newsimage class style rule, click after float: left;, press Enter, and type</p> <pre>margin-left: 15px;</pre> <p>to apply a margin to the news.jpg image.</p> <p><i>See Code Sample 3.</i></p> <p>(c) Save the file, switch to the Browser window, and refresh the page.</p> <p>(d) Observe that a margin has been applied to the left of the news.jpg image.</p>
<p>Code Sample 3</p> <pre>.newsimage { float: left; margin-left: 15px; }</pre>	
<p>4. Apply margins to the communities.gif image.</p>	<p>(a) Switch to the Notepad application.</p> <p>(b) In the image class style rule, click after float: right;, press Enter, and type</p> <pre>margin-left: 7px;</pre> <p>to apply margins to the left of the image.</p> <p><i>See Code Sample 4.</i></p> <p>(c) Press Enter and type</p>

margin-bottom: 30px;

to apply margins to the bottom of the image.

- (d) Save the file, switch to the **Browser** window, and refresh the page to verify that margins have been applied to the left and the bottom of the image.
