

# ACTIVITY 3-7

## Adding a Background Image:

### Data Files:

contact-info.html to your folder

clogo.jpg to your graphics folder

### Before You Begin:

Open the contact-info.html file to open it in Notepad and in a Browser window.

### Scenario:

Another coworker suggests that you add the logo image as a background image to the page containing the contact information. You plan to implement his idea but you do not want the background image to be tiled across the page.

What you do	How you do it
1. Add a background image to the page.	<p>(a) In the embedded style sheet, in the style rule for the <code>&lt;body&gt;</code> tag, click after <code>margin: 0;</code>, press <b>Enter</b>, and type</p> <p><b>background-image:</b> <b>url(graphics/clogo.jpg);</b></p> <p>to declare the logo graphic as a background image for the page.</p> <p><i>See Code Sample 1.</i></p> <p>(b) Save the file, switch to the <b>Browser</b> window, and refresh the page.</p> <p>(c) Observe that the logo graphic is placed as a background to the page and appears tiled.</p>
<p>Code Sample 1</p> <pre>body { margin: 0; background-image: url(graphics/clogo.jpg); }</pre>	
2. Prevent tiling of the image and position the image at the center of the page.	<p>(a) Switch to the Notepad application.</p> <p>(b) Press <b>Enter</b> and type</p> <p><b>background-repeat: no-repeat;</b></p> <p>to prevent the tiling of the image.</p> <p>(c) Press <b>Enter</b> and type</p> <p>background-position: center;</p> <p>to position the background image at the center of the page.</p> <p>(d) Save the file, switch to the <b>Browser</b> window, and refresh the page to verify that the background image does not tile across the page and is positioned at the center of the page.</p> <p>(e) Close the browser window.</p> <p>(f) In the <b>Notepad</b> window, close the contact-info.html file.</p>
