

ACTIVITY 4-3

Formatting the Table

Data Files:

info-center4-1.html

Before You Begin:

Open the info-center4-1.html file in the browser and in the Notepad application.

Scenario:

You have created the table body and the data has been entered, but you notice that the data in one column is too close to the data in the other column. You want to change the alignment of text to create more space between the data in the columns. You also feel that you can make the header row more distinct by applying a background color to it.

What you do	How you do it
1. Format the table text	<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. In the embedded style sheet, in the <code>table</code> style rule, click after the <code>width: 380px;</code> and press Enter and type Font-family: Arial, Verdana, sans-serif; Font-size: 12px; to specify the font and font size for the text in the table.b. Save the file, switch to the browser window, and refresh the page.c. Observe that the font family and font size of the text in the table have changed.d. Switch to the Notepad application.e. Press Enter and type text-align: center; to align the text to the center of the cells.f. Press Enter and type margin-left: 15px; to specify the margins for the table.g. Save the file, switch to the Browser window, and refresh the page.h. Observe that the text is aligned to the center of the cells and a left margin is applied to the table.

<p>2. Apply padding to the body cells</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Switch to the Notepad application. b. In the embedded style sheet, in the td style rule, click after border: solid 1px;, press Enter, and type padding: 2px; to specify the cell padding for the table cells. c. Save the file, switch to the Browser window, and refresh the page. d. Observe that the padding has been applied to the cells.
<p>3. Adding padding and a background color to the header cells.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Switch to the Notepad application. b. In the embedded style sheet, in the th style rule, click after border: solid 1px;, press Enter, and type padding: 2px; to specify the cell padding for the table header cells. c. Press Enter and type background-color: #cccccc; to apply a background color to the header cells. d. Save the file, switch to the Browser window, and refresh the page. e. Observe that the padding and background color have been applied to the header cells.
<p>4. Format the caption</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Switch to the Notepad application. b. In the embedded style sheet, click after the closing braces of the th style rule, press Enter and type caption { font-weight: bold; font-size: 13px; text-align: left; color: #001A5C; } c. Save the file, switch to the Browser window, and refresh the page to verify that the table caption is formatted with the styles you specified in the style rule. d. Close the browser window. e. In the Notepad window, close the info-center4-1.html file.
