

Background for your Site

Let work on some background colors and patterns. We will look at colors first.

On the CSS Panel double click `#wrapper`

Select the **Background Category**

Set the **background color** to `#FFFFFF` (this is white)

The wrapper holds all of your divs. Setting this to white will assure that you can read your text.

Now let's set a background color

On the CSS Panel double click `body`

Select the **Background Category**

Click the color swatch next to the **background color**

Your mouse will become an eye dropper.

Click somewhere in your banner to select a color

Click apply to test

To try another color click the swatch again and select from a different part of the banner.

Click apply to test

Once you are happy with your background color, click OK. Save All F12.

You may need to change the color of your buttons now that you have selected a background color and banner.

To change your button color double click `#wrapper #nav ul li a`

Select the **Background Category**

Click the swatch next to **background color**

Use the eye dropper to **select a color** from your header or your background so the buttons match well.

Click **Apply** to view.

When you are happy with your color click **OK**

To change the hover color double click `#wrapper #nav ul li a: hover`

Repeat the same process
