

## Creating Your Footer

In your code window select the text

*Content for id "footer" Goes Here* and press **delete**

On the **Insert panel** select **Insert Div Tag**

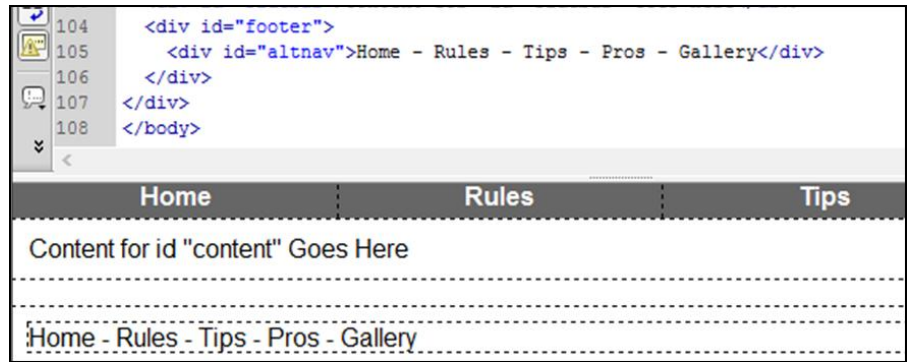
In the **ID** box name it **altnav**

and click ok

In your code window select the text

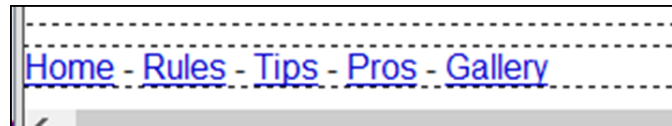
*Content for id "altnav" Goes Here* and press **delete**

Type **Home - Rules - Tips - Pros - Gallery**



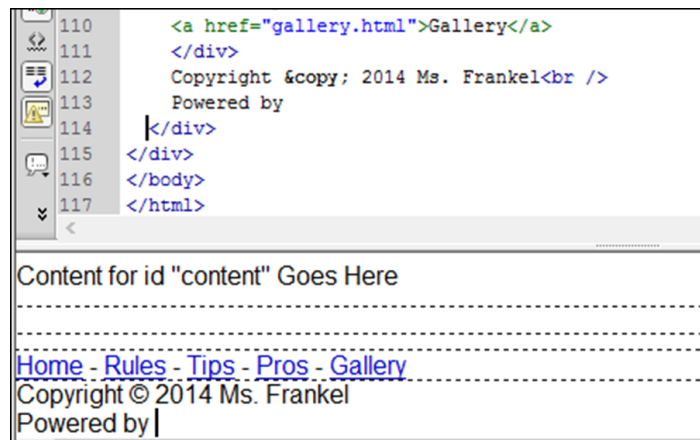
Highlight each item one at a time and enter the name of the page you want it linked to in the property inspector. Your code should look similar to the example below.

In your code window add the code you see below. Where it says Your Name, I want you to actually type your name.

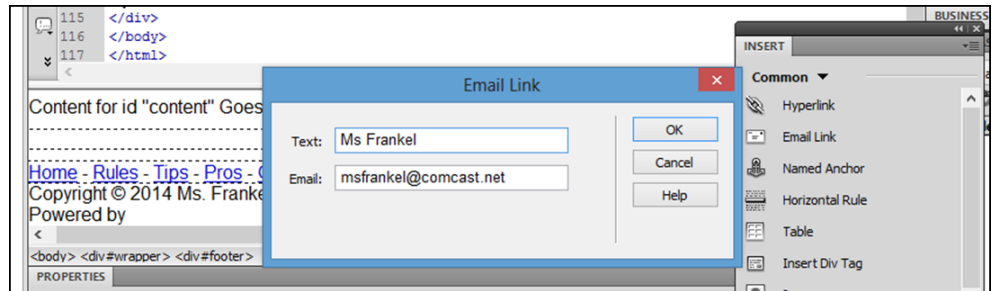
Now let's create an email link for you

Place your cursor right after  
powered by

On the **Insert Panel** select **Email Link**

In the **text box** type **your name**

In the **email box** type **your email  
address**



Now for the style

On the CSS panel double click **#footer**

Select the **Type Category**

Set the **Font-Family** to **Tahoma, Geneva, sans-serif**

Set the **Font-Size** to **12px**

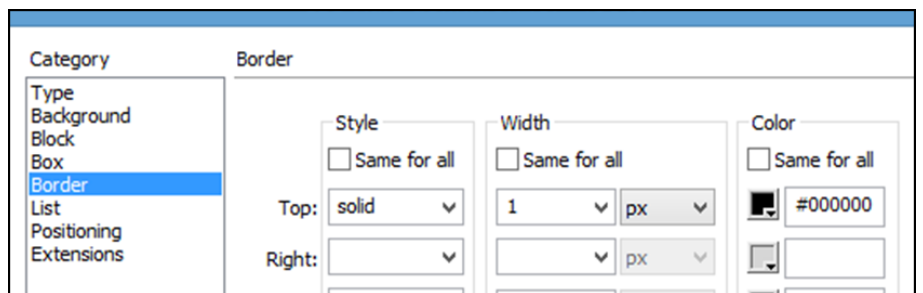
Select the **Border Category**

Uncheck same for all on all three

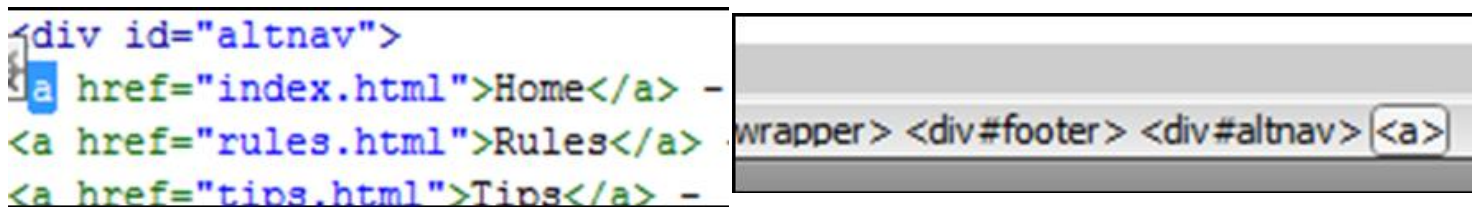
Set the **Style** to **Solid**

Set the **Width** to **1px**

Set the **Color** to **#000000** You can  
change this color later if you like.



Highlight the **a** in the code window. On the status bar click the **<a>**. Click the new rule button on the CSS panel.

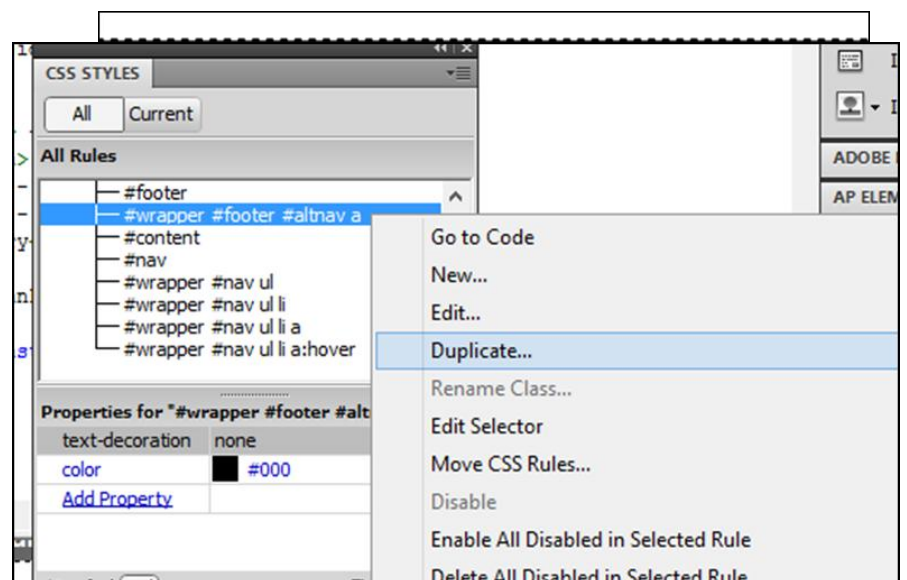


Select the **Type Category**

set the text-decoration to none  
set the font color to **#000000** you  
can change this color later if you  
color in your footer

Click ok

Now let's make them change when you  
hover over them.



Right mouse click on the #wrapper #footer #altnav a style you just worked on in the CSS styles panel.

Choose duplicate and at the end of #wrapper #footer #altnav a type :hover

click ok.

```
#wrapper #footer #altnav a:hover|
```

On in the CSS styles panel double click #wrapper #footer #altnav a:hover to open and edit.

Select the **Type Category**

set the **text-decoration** to **underline**  
**uncheck** the box that has **none**

Click ok

This will display an underline on the word when you hover on it. We are almost done.

The last thing left to do is float the alternate navigation to the right.

Note that floated elements must have a width specified to work properly, so set the width to slightly larger than the nav actually needs, and set the text alignment to right so the text sits where it should.

Select the text *altnav* in your code

On the status bar select <div #altnav>

Select the New CSS Style Button on the CSS Styles Panel and Click OK

```
<div id="altnav">

Select the **Box Category**

Set the **Float** to **right**

Set the **Width** to **350px**

Select the **Block Category**

Set the **text-align** to **right**

Click **OK**

File **Save All F12** to preview in browser
