Holiday Assignment

Create a Holiday Website:

*There are many different holidays around the world and many different ways to celebrate them.
You are going to create a website about a Holiday of your choice.*

Requirements:

- **5 page website minimum** – more if you'd like
- Required elements: minimum of
 - 1 unordered,
 - 1 ordered list,
 - 1 table,
 - 2 graphics,
 - Colors are tasteful and web compliant, easy to read.
 - Demonstrate your knowledge of design principles: consistent alignment, easy to read, easy navigation, balance, & contrast.
 - No spelling or grammar errors.
- Information about the holiday you chose: Chinese New Year, Christmas, Chanukah, Kwanzaa, Easter, Passover, Memorial Day, Easter, Independence Day, St Patrick's Day, Valentine's Day, etc.
- One folder Named: lastname_holiday,
 - There should only one other folder inside: images – this is where you will store photos used in your site. All images need to be downloaded – and stored in this file – do not link to the Internet.
 - All other pages and resources should be in the lastname_holiday folder.
- Each page needs to have a name:
 - index – this is the landing page- the Holiday home page
 - about- what is the holiday- perhaps its history-can also include how your family celebrates the holiday
 - recipes- favorite dishes and their recipes- you need to include at least 3 recipes
 - songs, poems, quotes, games, etc.
 - photos – either photos of your family celebrating the holiday or other images you acquire from the web
 - links- website about the holidays

Here are some ideas:

- What your holiday is, when it is or what it is about.
- Include a brief history of the holiday so people will understand where it came from.
- A fun thing to include here would be a description of how you and your family celebrate the holiday. If you really want to personalize this page you could include pictures of your family celebrating.
- Holiday recipes. Food is what makes most holidays and each holiday has its own special foods.
- Crafts or games that can be done or played to celebrate the holiday.
- Most holidays also have songs, poetry or prayers that go along with them as well. You may want to consider including the music or words for these on your site so others can learn them.
- If you know of other Web sites about this holiday you might want to include links to them as well.
