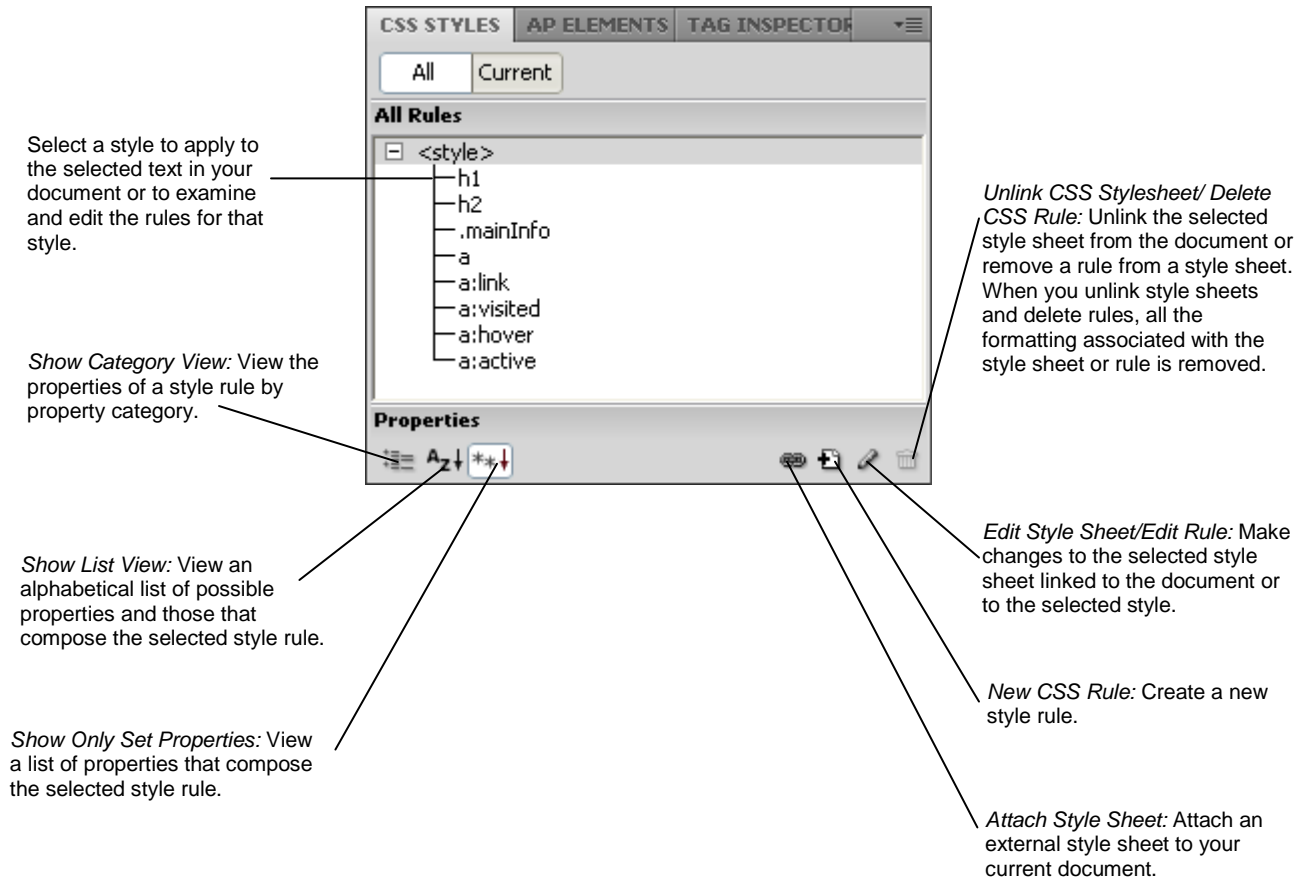



# CSS Styles panel

Use the CSS Styles panel to create, view, apply, or edit CSS styles for elements of a web page. In the All mode, the panel has two panes: All Rules and Properties.



In the Current mode, the panel has three panes: Summary For Selection, About, and Properties.
